



Grandmother's Hand – Evaluation-Tool



This method is a very effective and simple method for evaluating a project.

A grandmother is a wise old lady who is loving, caring, and supportive, but she is also honest about improvement-points.

This method is founded on her five fingers.

- 3 positive good things
- 2 things to improve

The project leaders draw a hand on the board and explain the method.

A. Every student writes those five points on a paper (3 positive/2 to be improved)

or

B The students get together in smaller groups and discuss and agree upon 5 points that they write on a paper

N.B. ALL THE POINTS MUST BE PRESENTED IN AN HONEST BUT GENTLE WAY

In plenum, the students or groups present the points that are written on the board by the project leaders

The project leaders document the evaluation and keep it for future projects





EXAMPLE: HARRY POTTER DAY

The project is presented by the language project class, and the rest of the school is participating in different Potter-related activities in English as foreign language.
